We will explore the Clinch River in kayaks and canoes on Saturday, September 18, 2010. Join us at the Scott County Horse Park in Dungannon, Virginia at 8:30 am and we will travel to the public boat ramp to begin our adventure. The approximately 6 hour float trip will be 9.5 miles to the Highway 72 Bridge in Ft. Blackmore.

While a limited number of canoes will be provided, you may choose to bring your own canoe or kayak. No jon boats, please. PFDs are required.
